Scholarships will be awarded in the following priorities:

First: A candidate needing academic training for a religious profession.

Second: A recent high school graduate entering a two or four year college.

Third: Adults entering or returning to a two-or four year college.

Fourth: Students pursuing continuing education

Fifth: Previous Tolt UCC scholarship winners.

Sixth: Candidates requiring additional vocational training or short-term vocational courses.
